A day on the racing venue on the Lake Palić, through eyes of Amy Ellerker

*Saturday 15th of July, I saw the second day of competition at the 2017 European University Rowing Championships. The action packed day consisted of **twelve repechages** and **two semi finals**.*

The day of racing involved close competition between crews battling it out for lane allocation and places in the impending EUSA rowing finals tomorrow (16.07.2017). The results below are from the repechages and semi finals races that commenced today (15.07.2017).

The first event of the day started with the LW1x race. The repechage saw the first four crews cruising into the A final and the final two crews positioning fifth and sixth to be allocated a spot in the B final. The A final line up for the LW1x will be:

*University of Manchester (UK)
Warsaw University of Life Sciences (Poland)
Kayimierz Wielki Uniwersytet w Bydgoszcz (Poland)
Erasmus University Rotterdam (The Netherlands)
Maastricht University (The Netherlands)
Delft University of Technology (The Netherlands)*

The next event of the day was the M2x repechage. The first two crews in this race will compete in the A final, whilst the crews that placed between third and fifth will race in the B final tomorrow. The A final line up for the M2x will be:

*Erasmus University, Rotterdam (The Netherlands)
Univerzitet Split (Croatia)
University of Birmingham (UK)
Brno University of Technology (The Netherlands)
University of Bremen (Germany)
Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Zurich (Switzerland)*



*Following on the repechage for the LM4- was next to take to the lake. The first four crews from this race were awarded a place in the A final, and the crews who finished between fourth and sixth have progressed through to the B final.
The LM4- A final line up is:*

University of Twente (The Netherlands)
Tilburg University (The Netherlands)
University of Amsterdam (The Netherlands)
Szechenyi Istvan University (Hungary)*



The W2x was the next event to compete. The repechage race saw the first two crews going through to the A final, whilst crews that positioned between third and fifth will compete in the B final. The top two crews from the repechage put in a solid performance with strong leads, convincingly placing them in the A final tomorrow. The W2x A final line up consists of:

Reading University (UK)
Latvian Academy of Sport Education (Latvia)
Loughborough University (UK)
Charles University (Czech Republic)
University of Amsterdam (The Netherlands)*



The M2- was the subsequent repechage to compete at the lake. The top two qualifiers from this race were selected for the A final. With this in mind, it provided close competition, with the first two qualifiers being less than one second apart, which is set to provide exciting racing ahead of tomorrow's final. The M2- A final tomorrow will consist of:

Czech University of Life Science Prague (Czech Republic)
Oxford Brookes University (UK)
University of Stuttgart (Germany)
Delft University of Technology (The Netherlands)
University of Lucerne (Switzerland)*

The W1x followed and the top two crews from the race will compete in the A final tomorrow, crews that positioned third and fourth will be in the B final.

The W1x A final line up consists of:

Latvian Academy of Sport Education (Latvia)
University of Munster (Germany)

The succeeding race was the LW2x. The top two crews from this repechage race will compete in the A final tomorrow. From the spectators view point, the top two crews across the line put in convincing wins and comfortably qualified for the A final. Crews that positioned between third and fifth will race the B final tomorrow.

The LW2x A final line up is :

The final repechage race of the day was for the final of the M8+. This race consisted of 9 crews competing for the A final. Due to the volume of entrants, it meant that there were two heats for the selection of crews in the M8+ A and B finals.

The top two crews from each heat will compete in the A final, including the two crews that qualified yesterday.

The afternoon session followed with a series of semi final races. The tightly contended races saw both the LM1x and the M1x events facing semi finals to confirm which crews would compete in either the A or B finals.

The first semi final to compete on Lake Palic was the LM1x. The close semi finals saw twelve crews battling it out for the A and B finals tomorrow.

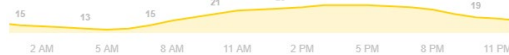
